Doctors at Fortis Anandapur Treat Bhutanese Patient Referred as Unusual Cardiac Tumour Case



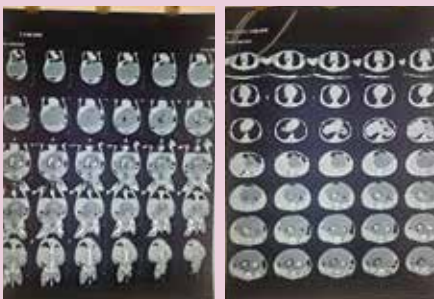

A team of doctors at Fortis Hospital, Kolkata, led by Dr K. M. Mandana, Director – Cardio Thoracic & Vascular Surgery, successfully treated a rare and complex cardiac case in a 53-year-old female patient from Bhutan. She was referred with a large right atrial (RA) tumour that occupied almost the entire chamber. The patient had a prior history of Takayasu's Aorto-Arteritis with mild Aortic Regurgitation (AR) and Aortic Stenosis (AS).

Upon detailed evaluation at Fortis Kolkata, advanced imaging including cardiac MRI and CT Pulmonary Angiography revealed a Sinus of Valsalva Aneurysm arising from the non-coronary cusp, extending extracardially as a large 8 × 8 × 7 cm sac filled with organized clots — compressing the interatrial septum and mimicking a right atrial myxoma.

Dr Mandana performed a complex open-heart surgery on October 6, 2025, involving Aortic Valve Replacement with a mechanical prosthesis, clot evacuation and pericardial patch repair of the aneurysm. The procedure took over 5 hours. The patient recovered well thereafter and was discharged in stable condition.

Rare Twin Parasitic Fetuses Removed from Month-old Baby Girl's Abdomen at Fortis Gurugram



Doctors at Fortis Memorial Research Institute, Gurugram successfully performed a rare and complex surgery to remove two parasitic fetuses from the abdomen of a one-month-old baby girl diagnosed with fetus-in-fetu, a rare congenital anomaly seen in only about 1 in 500,000 live births. With fewer than 300 such cases reported worldwide — and only about 35 involving multiple fetuses — this achievement marks a significant milestone in neonatal care. Led by Dr Anand Sinha, Director, Pediatric Surgery, and the pediatric surgical team, the delicate procedure was carried out with advanced surgical

techniques on July 30, 2025. The infant recovered well after receiving specialised neonatal care, and was discharged on August 4.

Doctors at Fortis Anandapur Treat Patient Who Fainted Frequently While Shaving or Applying Brakes on Bike



A team of doctors at Fortis Hospital, Anandapur, led by Dr Shuvan Ray, Director – Interventional Cardiology, has successfully treated a rare case of Subclavian Steal Syndrome. The 49-year-old male patient had been suffering from recurrent fainting episodes triggered by daily activities like shaving, applying brakes on his bike or any mild exertion using his hands. The patient had consulted multiple specialists but found no relief.

A detailed evaluation at Fortis Anandapur revealed a striking difference in the blood pressure readings of

both his arms. A CT angiography confirmed the complete occlusion of the left subclavian artery (a major blood vessel that supplies blood to the left arm, neck and brain), causing Subclavian Steal Syndrome, a rare condition that diverts blood away from the brain and causes dizziness and blackouts. Dr Ray performed a successful angioplasty of the left subclavian artery on September 15, 2025. Post procedure, the blood pressure normalised in both arms, and the patient's fainting spells disappeared. He was discharged in good health two days later, free from the debilitating symptoms that had disrupted his life.

Fortis Hospital, Gurugram Marks One Year of Transforming Cancer Care with North India's First MR Linac



On September 27, 2025, Fortis Hospital, Gurugram celebrated one year of the MR Linac — North India's first and the second in the country. Over the past year, this advanced technology has successfully treated 187 patients with complex cancers, providing shorter treatment durations, fewer side effects, and improved recovery outcomes.

The celebrations began with a press conference and video launch at Fortis Hospital, Gurugram, followed by a clinical session and dinner at the Taj City Centre. The event was graced by Dr. Ashutosh Raghuvanshi, MD & CEO, Fortis Healthcare, who delivered an inspiring address highlighting FMRI's pioneering efforts in precision oncology. Over 310 eminent clinicians and experts from India and abroad attended the occasion to commemorate the milestone and exchange insights on the future of cancer care.

This remarkable achievement reflects the vision and leadership of Dr. A.K. Fortis Hospital, Shalimar Bagh Performs North West Delhi's First MitraClip Procedure



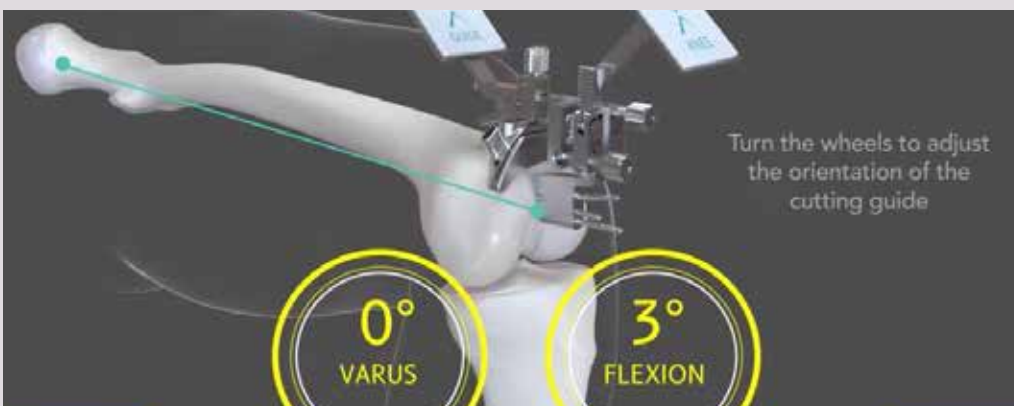

Dr Rohit Dadhwal of Fortis Mohali completes 100 cases of Rezūm



Dr Rohit Dadhwal, Consultant - Urology Andrology and Robot-aided Surgery, Fortis Hospital, Mohali, has successfully completed 100 cases of Rezūm (Water Vapour Therapy) for Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia (BPH) – the latest form of minimal invasive surgical treatment to relieve prostate obstruction. This makes Dr Dadhwal the second urologist in the country to achieve this milestone. The daycare, minimally-invasive treatment, uses natural water vapour to shrink the prostate, offering quick recovery, durable relief, and preserved quality of life without the need of anaesthesia.

Fortis Hospital, Jalandhar, Performs City's First Augmented Reality–Based Knee Replacement Procedure

Fortis Hospital, Jalandhar, achieved a major medical milestone by performing the city's first Augmented Reality (AR) Artificial Intelligence–based Navigation Total Knee Replacement (Pixee Knee+). The breakthrough surgery was conducted on September 16 2025 by Dr Mohit Sharma, Consultant – Orthopaedics & Knee Replacement Surgeon, on a 65-year-old woman suffering from severe arthritis and restricted mobility for over five years.

With the advanced AR navigation system, the team achieved exceptional precision and alignment, ensuring faster recovery and improved mobility. The patient was able to walk within days of the procedure and reported significant pain relief.

DON'T MISS A BEAT

Fortis Hiranandani Hospital, Vashi



To mark World Heart Day 2025, Fortis Hiranandani Hospital, Vashi showcased a series of impactful initiatives under its Navi Mumbai Heart Network, all aimed at improving heart health outcomes across the region. Key efforts included:

- PAMI collaboration: Partnering with nursing homes within a 5 km radius to reduce door-to-balloon time by 24%, enabling faster treatment for severe heart attacks.
- Early detection drive: Installation of TMT machines in Nagothane industrial belt led to 625 screenings since June 2024, identifying 65 high-risk patients (≈10%) for early intervention.
- Outreach OPDs: Clinics in Palava, Khopoli, Panvel, Roha, and Nagothane seeing 130+ patients every month, with 6–8% referred for hospital-based care—most returning to normal life within 15 days.
- Workforce strengthening: Launch of a nurses training program that certified 50 nurses in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and emergency response, boosting regional readiness.

On World Heart Day, the hospital hosted a hands-on cardiology workshop, "Don't Miss a Beat," bringing together healthcare professionals, emergency responders, media, and community members for in-depth sessions on the PAMI pathway, Acute Coronary Dydrome, and life-saving cardiac procedures. The initiative was led by Dr Anil Potdar, Director-Cardiology; Dr Prashant Pawar, Consultant-Interventional Cardiology; Ms Mohini Chandrashekhar, Chief Nursing Officer; Dr Preetam Gaikwad, Head-Emergency Medicine and Ms Sonam Juikar, Nurse Educator, with support from Dr Swapnil Khadake, HOD & Consultant Critical Care and Dr Priyanka Naik, Medical Services.

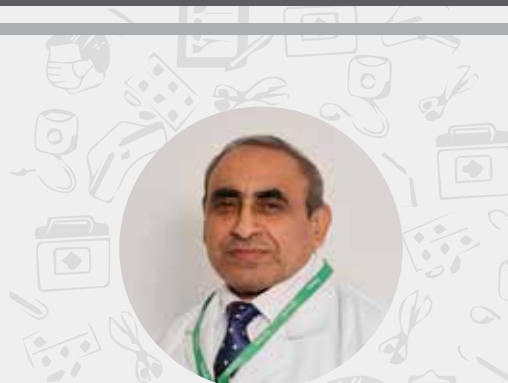

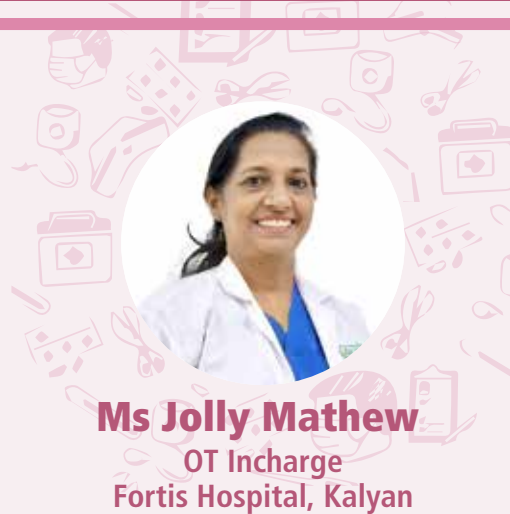
Has being a clinician/doctor influenced your perspective on health practices in personal life as well?

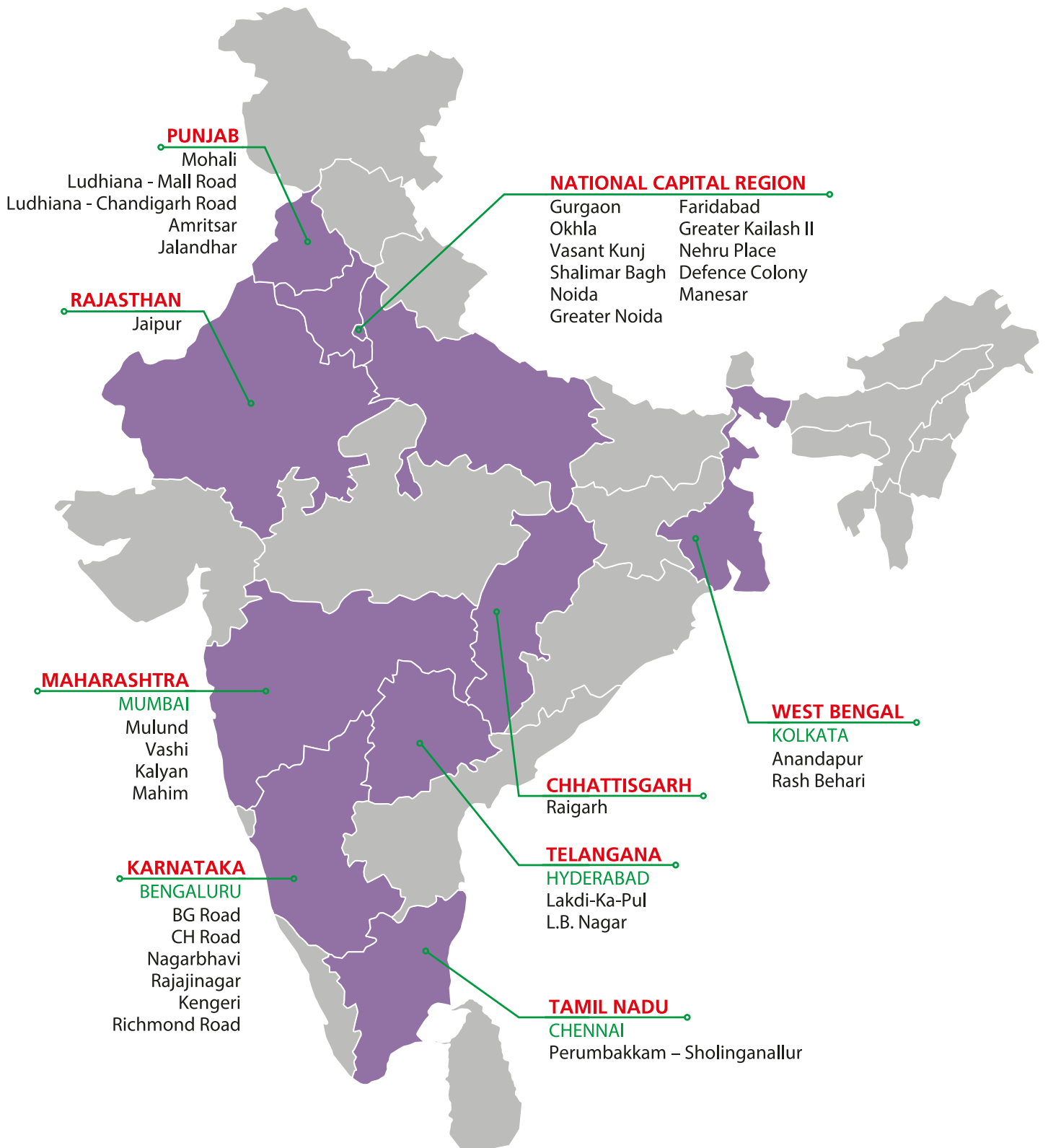
